Morning Arrival and Afternoon Dismissal

Dear Parents/Guardians:
We know dropping off and picking up your scholars from school is not the most fun. We understand parents have to go to work, drop off other children at other schools, or have pressing appointments that they need to get to. We only ask everyone to be patient, understanding, and abide by the safety guidelines we have put in place for the safety of your scholars, staff, and the community we reside in.

Safety First:

1. Have scholars fully prepared and ready to exit the car.
2. Drive all the way through the traffic cones to drop off at the gate.
3. Do not exit your car, any questions can be made by calling our office or asking your child's teachers.

6. Do not leave your children unattended.
